Deadline extended - Community representatives sought for Peacekeeper Ethics Committee

(Kahnawake – 13, Tsothohrkó:wa/January 2015) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is seeking four (4) community members to fill vacant positions on the Peacekeeper Ethics Committee for the 2015-2019 service term. **The deadline to make a submission has been extended to Monday, January 26th, 2015.**

Subject to the provisions of the Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers Law, any Mohawk of Kahnawà:ke who is at least twenty-one (21) years old and resides within the Mohawk Territory of Kahnawà:ke is eligible to be a member of the Ethics Committee.

Ethics Committee representatives receive an honorarium to compensate for their time.
