Dates and new format announced for seasonal Community Meetings

(Kahnawake – 3, Enníska/February 2024)

The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke Office of the Council of Chiefs (OCC) wishes to inform Kahnawà:kehró:non that the Community Meeting dates have been set for 2024 and that there is a planned format change to how they will be moderated.

Further to an evaluation of previous Community meetings and feedback from concerned community members, the Ratitsénhaienhs have determined that a new meeting format is essential to increase their effectiveness. This new format will encourage respectful dialogue and ensure that the meetings remain a space that is both productive and safe for all. Community members are encouraged to review the [proposed guidelines](#) that will be in effect at the next meeting, scheduled for Wednesday, 28 Enníska/February.

Community meetings are a tool for community members to engage with and receive information from Ratitsénhaienhs. Feedback on the guidelines will be received until Thursday, February 15, at 4pm. Feedback can be submitted in several ways:
