(Kahnawake – 8, Enniskó:wa/March 2018) The Kahnawà:ke Legislative Coordinating Commission (KLCC) would like to inform the community that the date has been set for the commencement of the Second Hearing phase for the proposed amendments to the Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke Law (formerly known as the Kahnawà:ke Membership Law). The meeting will be held on Tuesday, 20 Enniskó:wa/March 2018 at the Legion Hall.

The draft *Kanien'kehá:ka of Kahnawà:ke Law* was published for the Community Feedback period from December 20, 2017 to January 31, 2017, after the conclusion of the First Hearing phase of the Community Decision Making Process.
