**(Kahnawake – 30, Enniskó:wa/March 2021)** The Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 Task Force wishes to advise the community that the Mass Vaccination Center has new hours of operation for walk-ins. Community members who wish to get their vaccine without making an appointment can **walk-in** this week:

- Tuesday, 9am to 5pm
- **Wednesday and Thursday, 11am to 7pm**
- Friday, 9am to 5pm
- Saturday, Sunday and Monday – **CLOSED**

Additionally, this will be the last week for prioritization of community members. Residents who book their vaccination appointments on-line will have priority, and not be required to wait in line.
