**(Kahnawá:ke – 2, Onerahtohkó:wa / May 2007)** The Kahnawá:ke Environment Protection Office would like to inform the community that they will be performing “Species at Risk” field work over the next few months.

Work begins today with Kahnawá:ke Environment Technologist, Holly McComber, and Louis Phillippe Gagnon, a consultant from the St. Lawrence Valley Natural History Society, conducting studies under Hydro Quebec lines in the areas of the "Big Fence" and the Kahnawá:ke Survival School.

Today the pair will be searching for the Western Chorus Frog, as part of a study of reptiles and amphibians within the Territory. McComber is driving a Toyota Tercel and Gagnon, a Toyota Echo.
