It was created to honor the late Lori Niioié:ren Jacobs – a strong, independent and remarkable Kanien'kehá:ka woman who was well-known for her involvement in numerous activities, causes, boards of directors, commissions and organizations, as well as her incredible work ethic. Lori volunteered and worked tirelessly throughout her life to make her community a better place. She passed away on April 21st, 2016.

The Award is accompanied by a \$1000 bursary. It is presented to an individual who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to Kahnawà:ke with his/her involvement in activities that were integral to Lori's life.
