## Task Force announces new Directives, Phase 2 dates

#### For immediate release

**(Kahnawake – 25, Ohiarí:ha/June 2020)** The Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 Task Force wishes to advise the community of the dates for the 'Reopening of Kahnawà:ke' Phase 2.

#### Effective immediately:

- Outdoor Public Gatherings to a maximum of 50 people are permitted
- Outdoor and Indoor Gatherings of maximum of 10 people are permitted in a private residence
- Travel Restrictions for essential services have been lifted; travel within Canada is permitted with restrictions based on various provinces Provinces.
- Important: International Travel, including the United States, <u>remains prohibited</u>

As of Wednesday, July 1<sup>st</sup> the following Directives will be in effect:

- Dine-In Kahnawà:ke Restaurants will be permitted to open, provided they have completed a health inspection. (Bar section of Restaurants will remained closed)
- **Churches** will reopen, respecting <u>maximum capacity of 50 people</u>, if space is available
- Yard Sales and similar activities will be permitted
- Indoor Cleaning Services will be permitted
- Non-Contact Outdoor Organized Sports will be permitted provided they have a safety plan that is approved
