## Border Travel Reminder

(Kahnawake – 21, Ohiarikhó:wa/July 2021)

The Public Safety Commission wishes to remind the community that the United States-Canada border is still closed to non-essential travel. Anyone who decides to cross the border **MUST** comply with all enforced border regulations of the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA).

Public Safety and Public Health are **NOT** responsible for the rules and regulations in place at the border. The Kahnawà:ke Peacekeepers receive information from the CBSA to ensure follow-up on those re-entering Canada, as per normal protocols.
