## School busses back to full capacity, masks still mandatory

**(Kahnawà:ke – 23, Seskéha/August 2022)**

The Daily Transportation Department of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke wishes to advise the community that school busses will be permitted to return to operating at full capacity for the upcoming school year.

All routes will return to pre-pandemic times and availability. Capacity levels had been reduced due to COVID-19 during the past two years.

As we are still in the pandemic, **all students and monitors will be required to wear masks at all times while on the bus.** Bus drivers will be required to wear masks while entering and exiting a bus, or when entering the passenger area. Please note that, for safety reasons, it is NOT mandatory for a driver to wear a mask while driving. Masks will be made available for students who forget to bring one.
