(Kahnawake – 27, Seskehkó:wa/September 2024) The Office of the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry (OKKR) would like to remind the community of the upcoming information session happening on Wednesday, October 2nd, from 1:30pm to 3:30pm held at the Okwari Room, located on the second floor of the Kahnawà:ke Services Complex. The Information Session will provide a detailed overview of the application process for both recognition and residency on the Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Registry (KKR).

A second session is scheduled for Tuesday, October 29th, from 6pm to 8pm.

These sessions will focus on the process for applying to be recognized on the KKR, obtaining Approved Kahnawà:ke Resident authorization, and applying for Residency Permits. Additionally, attendees will receive information about the forthcoming launch of the Complaints Process for eviction of an individual in violation of the *Kahnawà:ke Residency Law*.

Though no applications will be distributed or accepted during the sessions, copies of the *Kahnawà:ke Kanien'kehá:ka Law* and the *Kanien'kehá:ka Registry Law* will be available for review.
