## Microchipping Clinic for Cats and Dogs

#### For immediate release

**(Kahnawake – 9, Kenténha/October 2024)** The Public Safety Division's Animal Control Services is excited to announce a community-wide microchipping clinic for your beloved pets.

A Veterinarian and veterinary technician will be on-site to perform the service for pet owners. The pet owner's contact information is stored on the microchip, about the size of a grain of rice, and inserted under the skin between the pet's shoulder blades. It is a standard procedure for Veterinarians, animal shelters, and Animal Control Officers to check for these microchips.

The clinic takes place on **Saturday**, **October 26**<sup>th</sup>, **from 1pm to 5pm** at the Animal Control Office located near the Peacekeeper station on the Old Malone Highway.

### Why Microchip your pet?

- **Permanent:** A Microchip is a permanent form of identification It will never get lost or fall off
- **Safety:** Lost pets with a microchip generally have a higher return rate than those without one
- Travel Requirements: As of August 1, 2024, all pets must be microchipped to travel over the border

Normally this service costs \$40, but for this clinic only, the cost is just **\$25.** Kahnawa'kehró:non only. Appointments are required and will be scheduled every 10 minutes. Call **450-632-0635**, ext. **53527** to secure your spot.
