(Kahnawake – 5, Kentenhkó:wa/November 2024) The Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke is pleased to announce the return of the Canadian Pacific Kansas City (CPKC) Holiday Train, glowing with holiday spirit as 2024 marks its 26th anniversary! The Holiday Train will make a special stop at Adirondack Junction in Kahnawà:ke at approximately 4:45pm on Sunday, November 24th, with the show scheduled to begin at 5pm.



This year's musical performers will include the James Barker Band and Clerel, promising an exciting evening for attendees. Santa Claus will also make an appearance, ready to spread holiday cheer and take photos with everyone.

Volunteers will be on-site distributing hot chocolate and snacks, while accepting cash and food donations. All proceeds will benefit the **Kateri Food Basket**, supporting those in need within the community. Since its inception in 1999, the CPKC Holiday Train has raised over \$24.3 million and collected more than 5.3 million pounds of food for food banks across North America.
