While she began her position on November 23<sup>rd</sup>, she has spent most of her time preparing herself for the most important part of her duties: assisting community members in preparing claims, which can be submitted until July 13, 2022.

The Coordinator is responsible for providing information to Kahnawa'kehró:non on all matters related to the Indian Day School Settlement agreement. Due to the pandemic, she will be working from home for the time being.
